CONTINUED COMMITMENT TO COMPLIANCE

As one of the leading providers of components and aftermarket support to airlines and aviation entities all over the world, Avtrade is committed to transporting its products in accordance with the export control laws and regulations of the United Kingdom, United States, Europe and those of other countries relevant to our business operation.

Export control legislation affects many aspects of Avtrade's business including all forms of component and product purchase, sale and transportation to move goods and between third party countries (including the transmission of software or technology by telephone or electronic media).

The purpose of these controls is to limit the supply of strategic goods, software and technology to reduce risks to national security and terrorism. It is in the interests of Avtrade as an employer, its workforce and wider global safety and security that these controls are strictly adhered to.

Avtrade has over many years complied fully with relevant legislation and it is our intent to continue to comply with all relevant export laws and regulations.

As C.E.O., I continue to nominate the Director of Operations to have overall responsibility for Export Control within Avtrade assisted by the Technical Logistics Manager.

As responsible employees of Avtrade, we must all be aware of our individual and corporate roles in ensuring that under no circumstances should a transaction or shipment occur contrary to our policy and current legislation. Failure to do so may bring penalties for Avtrade and any individual concerned in deliberate breach.
